We offer you cash rebates and free consultation to assist you with purchasing and installing eligible energy efficient equipment. You can reduce your energy consumption and lower upfront equipment costs; which means a better investment for your company.

Take advantage of these programs:

The **LIGHTENUP** program provides cash rebates for replacing your old lighting equipment with a new energy-efficient lighting system. Incentives cover fixtures, lamps and control systems that will save you money. Incentives can cover up to 60% of project costs and are based on wattage reduction and the type of lighting installed. The **Cooling Rebate Program (CRP)** provides cash rebates for replacing or updating your cooling system with high efficient cooling equipment and optimal control systems. Rebates are based on efficiency ratings and size of equipment, so contact your HVAC contractor to find out how to purchase eligible cooling equipment. The **Custom Electric Efficiency** program offers cash incentives and assistance for custom electric efficiency projects that do not fit into the above standard rebate programs. You must receive pre-approval for these projects. Incentives are based on the energy or demand savings (\$0.10 per annual kilowatt-hour or \$500 per kilowatt demand), up to 60% of the improvement cost.

Energy efficiency projects may include:

- Integrated Design Assistance Process
- New construction energy efficiency
- Motor replacement
- Industrial and manufacturing processes
- Variable Frequency Drives (VFDs)
- Refrigeration equipment and controls
- Envelope improvements
- Compressed Air Efficiency
