Financial Support

In November, 2008, voters showed District support by approving a mill levy override in the amount of \$16.5 million and a bond for \$189 million.

Academic Accomplishments

- 73% of students in St. Vrain are Proficient or Advanced in reading
- St. Vrain students performed better than the state average in 86% of the CSAP exams
- 10 District schools showed "high growth" in CSAP exams in one or all of the subject areas – reading, writing and math
- Almost 50% of secondary students currently take an advanced level course(s)
- St. Vrain offers 28 focus school programs
- Education Foundation of the St. Vrain Valley has awarded over \$1.5 million back to the District in classroom grants, community projects, technology upgrades and student scholarships
